

The focus and hero of the Bible is Jesus. In some way, every part of the Bible points forward to Christ or points back to Him.


A COLLECTION



You have great significance and great worthy.



• EVALUATE

Is your sin especially serious and deep-rooted?

• FILL

Immerse your mind and conscience with the guilt, the weight, and the evil of your sin

• CONSIDER

Think on whether there is something in your makeup that makes you especially prone to sin

• LONG

Desire deliverance from sin

• CONTEMPLATE

Think on and figure out the occasions on which this sin breaks out and guards against them

• MEDITATE

Pursue God in your thoughts to see His glory and your desperate inability. Think about God. Read His Word and meditate on it

• BATTLE

Fight hard against the first awakenings of that sin. Never, ever allow yourself to play with sin

• EXPECT

Desire to hear and know that God will speak peace to your soul (but do not speak it to yourself until He does)

• PURSUE

Where you have a certain vice in your life, an especially strong temptation to sin, or an especially strong history of sin, you will have to work extra hard to put that sin to death and to put on the opposite virtue

• REPLACE

We also need to generally pursue godly character. There are some areas where you are not particularly prone to sin, and in these areas, you need to generally pursue godliness




KINDNESS




Our value is not tied to our money. The gospel tells us that we are all valued equally and value is demonstrated by Jesus in giving up His life for us.

Material wealth is a trap and can be very deceiving as we are addicted to more. We need to pray, read Proverbs, and learn from other financially savvy Christians.

God demands a return on His investment. An owner doesn't give his money to a steward to lose it. We can't take it with us after we die.

BODY



We were bought with a price. Our bodies do not belong to us. The gospel tells us that we don't need to provide them every pleasure to experience joy and peace.

We must seek wisdom on how to steward our bodies because our culture tells us that we own them. We have been told that we hold all the cards and even get to decide whether our body lives or dies.

We are to train and protect our bodies because God values them as the temple of the Holy Spirit. We are commanded to sacrifice our bodies and to serve others. Therefore we must care for them well.

CHILDREN



Children are a gift from God and a picture of how God sacrificed selflessly for us. But we don't expect our children to provide the joy that only Jesus gives.

Learn as much as possible from other godly parents. Listen and watch them. Read good books and pray constantly for wisdom.

We are to train up our children in the way of the Lord so that they might be saved and then train up future generations.
